- Assemble parts off of drawings to build battery packs, position, align, and fasten subassemblies, assemblies using hand and power tools.
- Troubleshoot battery packs and components for mechanical and electrical issues with limited supervision.
- Perform basic quality and functional tests of completed packs.
- Some rework, repair and minor fabrication will be required, to include but not limited to cleaning, soldering, harness updates, welding, etc.
- Maintain detailed service and warranty records, handwritten and data based.
- Perform routine daily cleanup.
- Team player, flexible, and eager to learn.
