About the Role

The Maintenance Technician will perform corrective and preventive maintenance tasks on manufacturing equipment and the facility. Must work independently with minimal supervision to complete required tasks and responsibilities. When needed for production support, the Maintenance Technician may support the manufacturing assembly process, receiving direction from the Lean Mfg. Manager.

What you Will be Doing

- Assemble, install, and integrate various equipment following established processes.
- Manage and perform Preventative Maintenance of equipment and the facility.
- Maintain work orders on a daily and weekly basis. Documents all machine preventative, predictive and/or maintenance repairs clearly and concisely for historical and future maintenance purposes.
- Support all facility related requests that can be addressed internally (i.e., paint, plumbing, drywall, etc.), contractors may be required for larger projects.
- Must understand and adhere to safety standards as set forth by the company. Support safety improvements as a number one priority, including maintaining 6S floor tape maintenance as required.
- Ability to use customary shop equipment such as drill press, grinders, sanders, band saws, and welding and cutting.
- Responsible for the facility housekeeping maintenance including organization and management of waste which includes pallets, scrap materials, and any hazardous materials.
- Assist manufacturing, stockroom, receiving, & shipping teams with projects or support when needed.
- Effectively and accurately report status updates, for preventive maintenance, improvements, and repairs.
- Provide weekly report of all work activities to supervisor, daily report may be required when requested.
- Support coordination with outside vendors for maintenance related activities including trash, scrap & recycling, forklift maintenance, and any other related activities.
- Other tasks and responsibilities relating to the support of the manufacturing operation and facility.
- Off hour work required to maintain equipment during downtime, may include weekends.
- Ability to support emergency call ins when not previously scheduled to work.

Required Education and Skills:

- 5 to 10 years related experience in a manufacturing environment.
- Skilled in the use of small hand tools including wrenches, drivers, and crimpers as well as power tools including saws, sanders, drills, and grinders.
- Must have the experience and knowledge to use electrical equipment for installation and preventive maintenance of equipment.
- Reads and interprets equipment manuals, schematics, and work orders to perform required maintenance and service.



- Attention to detail and good verbal / written communications skills a must for reporting status.
- Recommended intermediate computer skills including applications such as MS Word, Excel, Outlook, Internet browsers, and product specific or OEM equipment utilities and applications.
